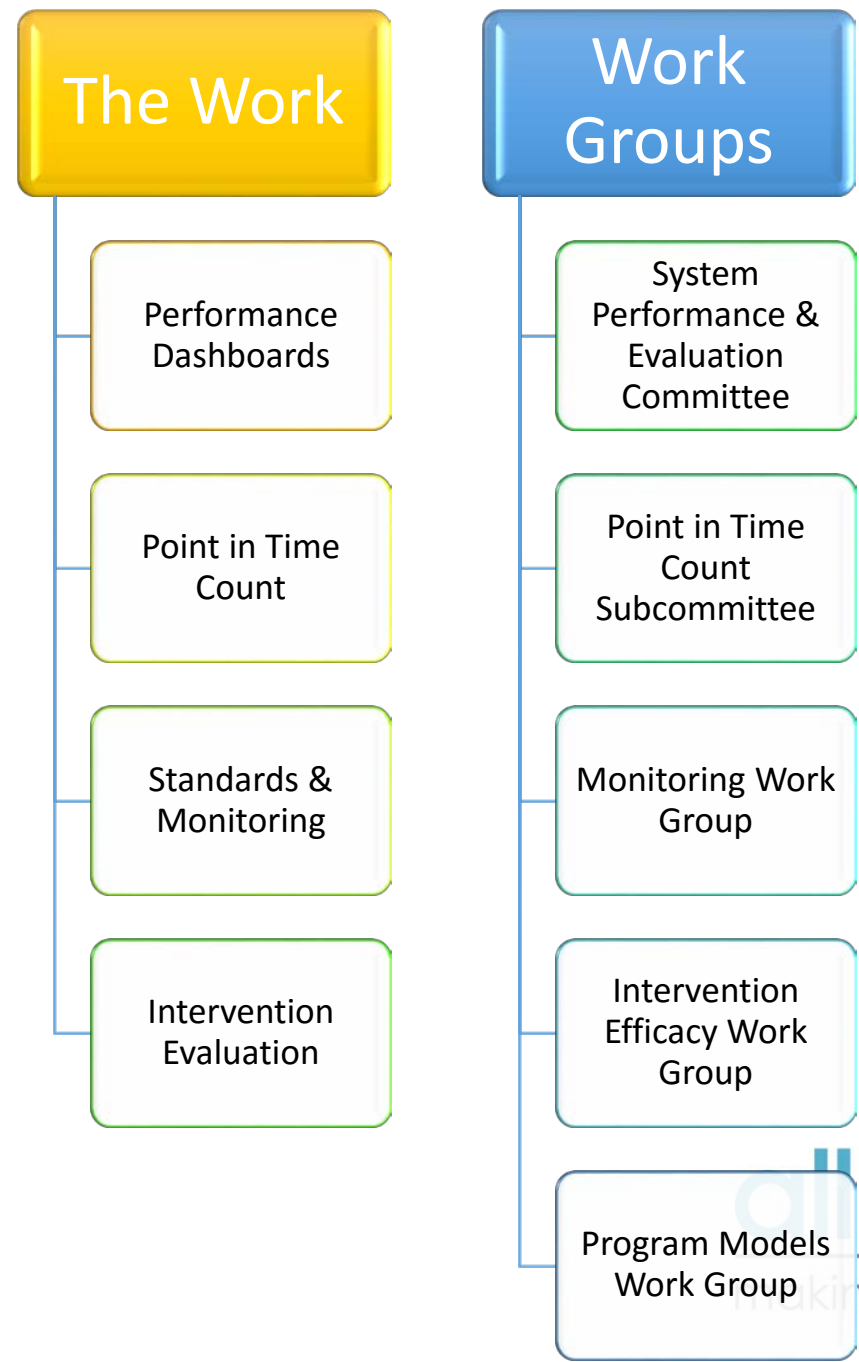

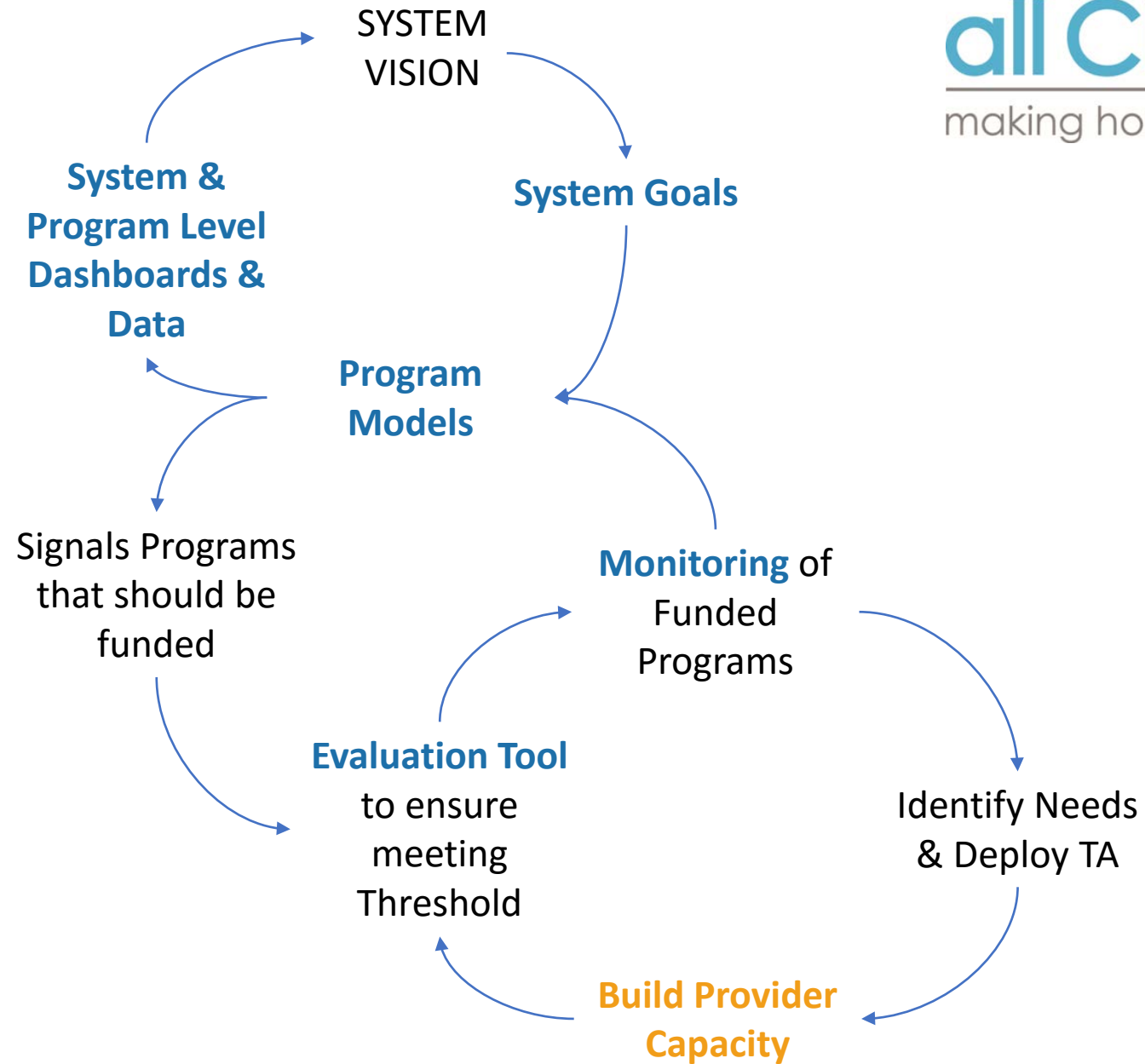


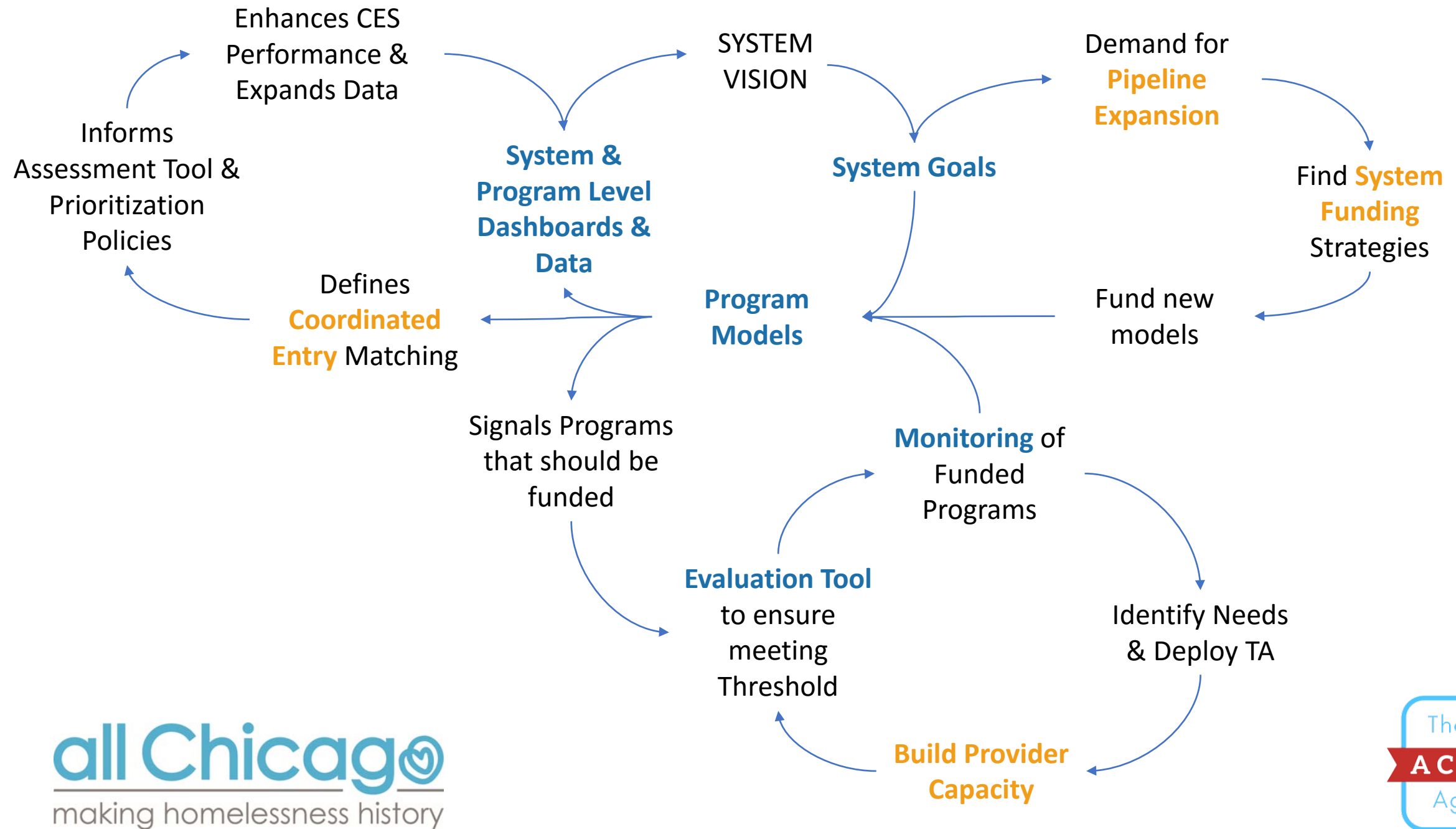

# System Goals

All individuals and families resolve their homeless crisis in 90 days (Ultimate Goal)

- Time from match to housing is 30 days for all populations
- 25% of people exiting with increased income due to employment
- Chicago-based SOAR applications in 2018 will increase by 10% in comparison to 2017.

End chronic homelessness for Veterans by 12/31/18

Reduce chronic homelessness by 25%.

- All units are filled through coordinated entry.
- Create 100 new units of PSH for chronically homeless and most vulnerable in the next 18 months.
- Ensure all chronic homeless have an available unit

# System Goals

Reduce street homelessness by 25% by 2020

Reduce the number of youth experiencing homelessness by 25%

Reduce the number of families experiencing homelessness by 25%

- Define youth homelessness & set appropriate benchmarks.
- Create 80 new units of rapid-rehousing for youth
- Create additional youth diversion supports
- Add 25 units low threshold interim housing for youth

- Create 100 new units of RRH in the next 18 months.

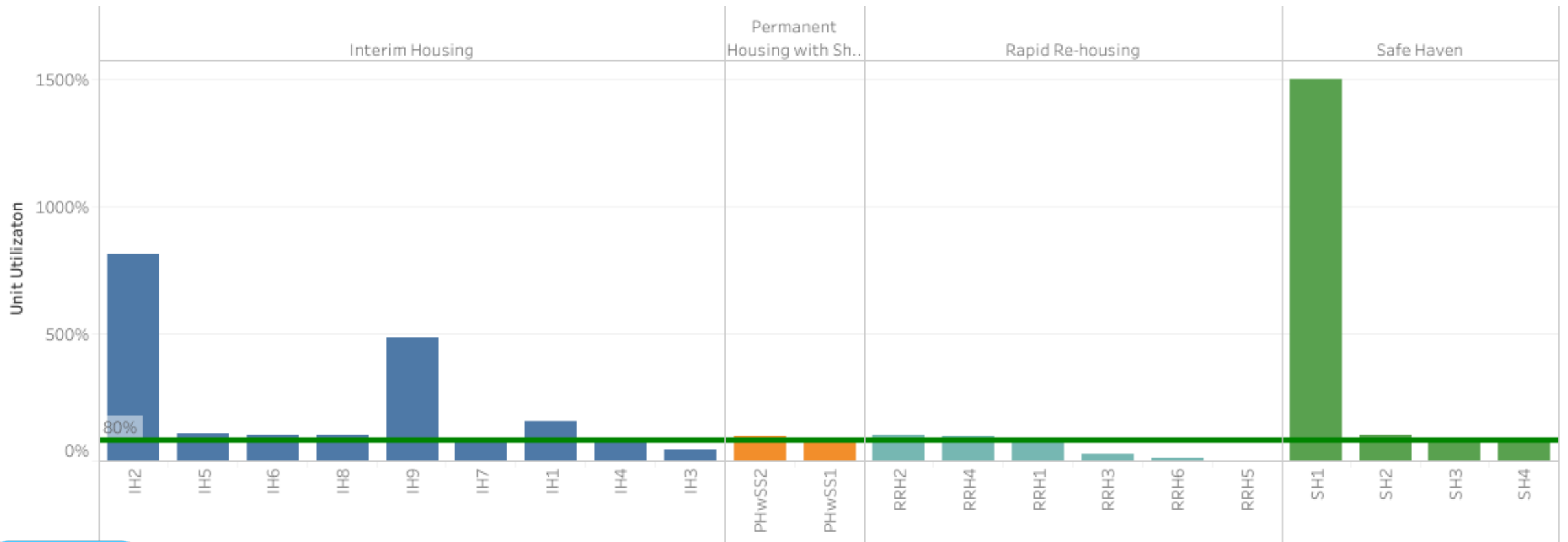

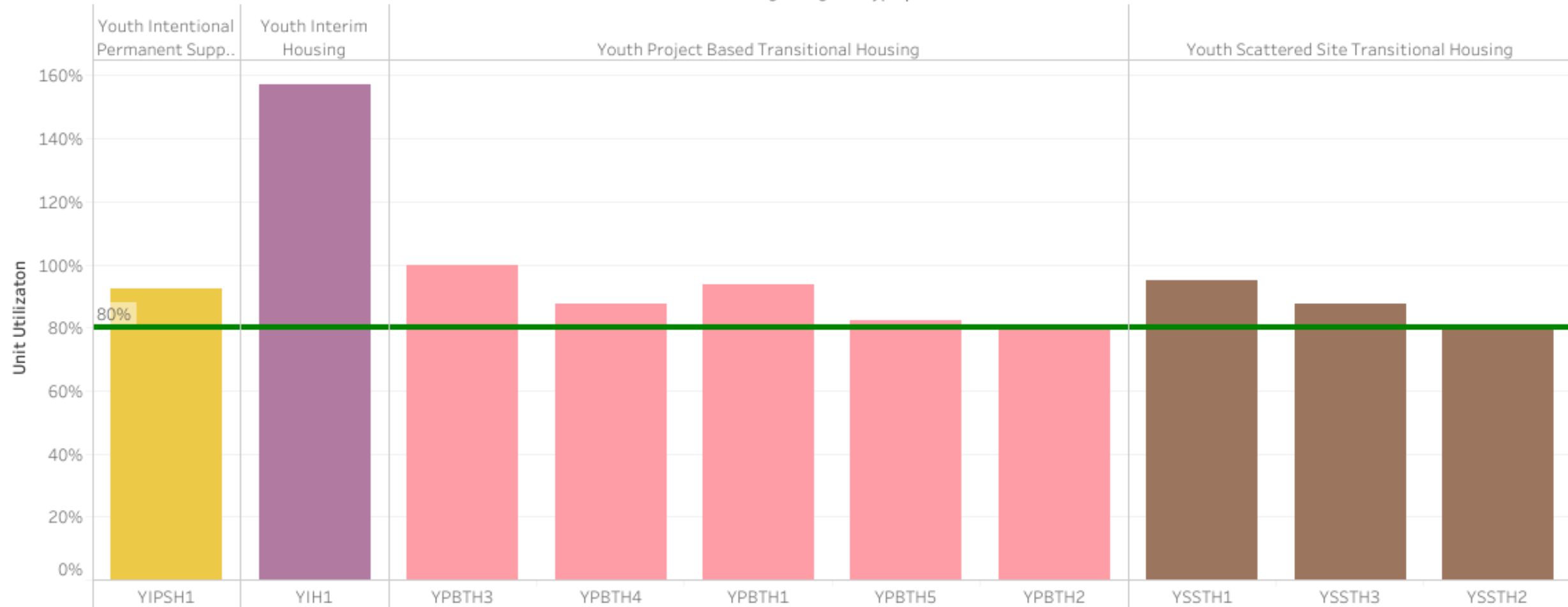
# Unit Utilization (2018)



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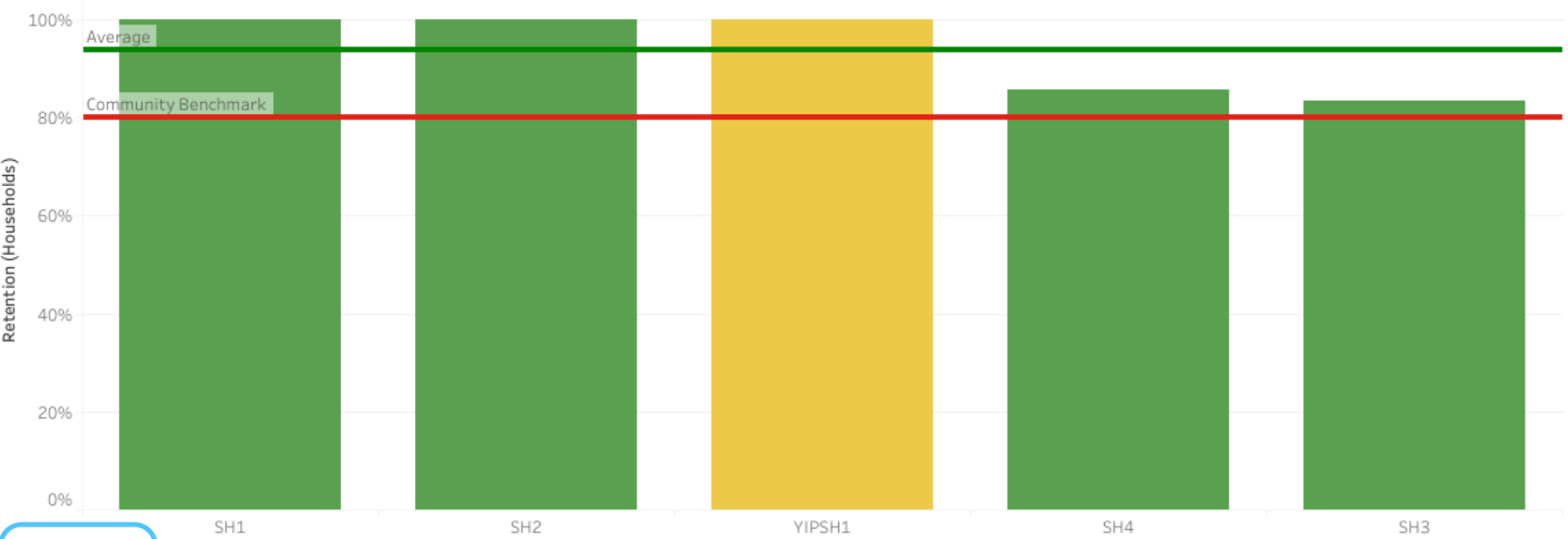

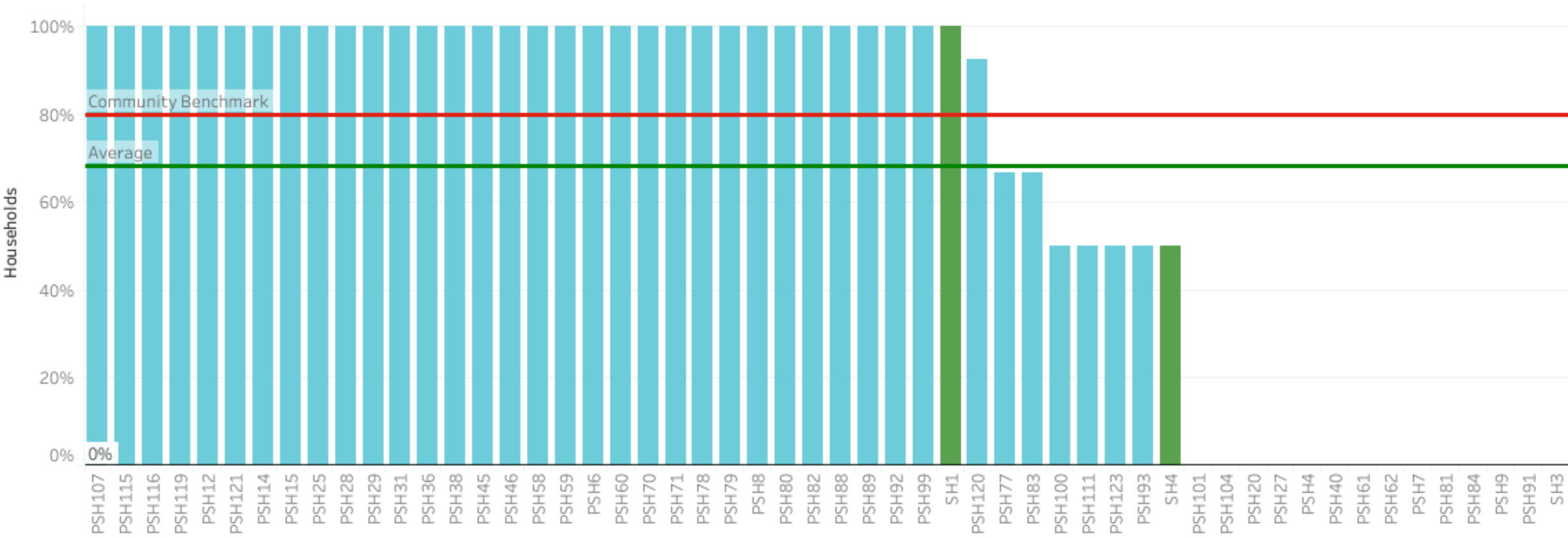


# Safe Haven & Youth PSH Retention in Housing (2018)





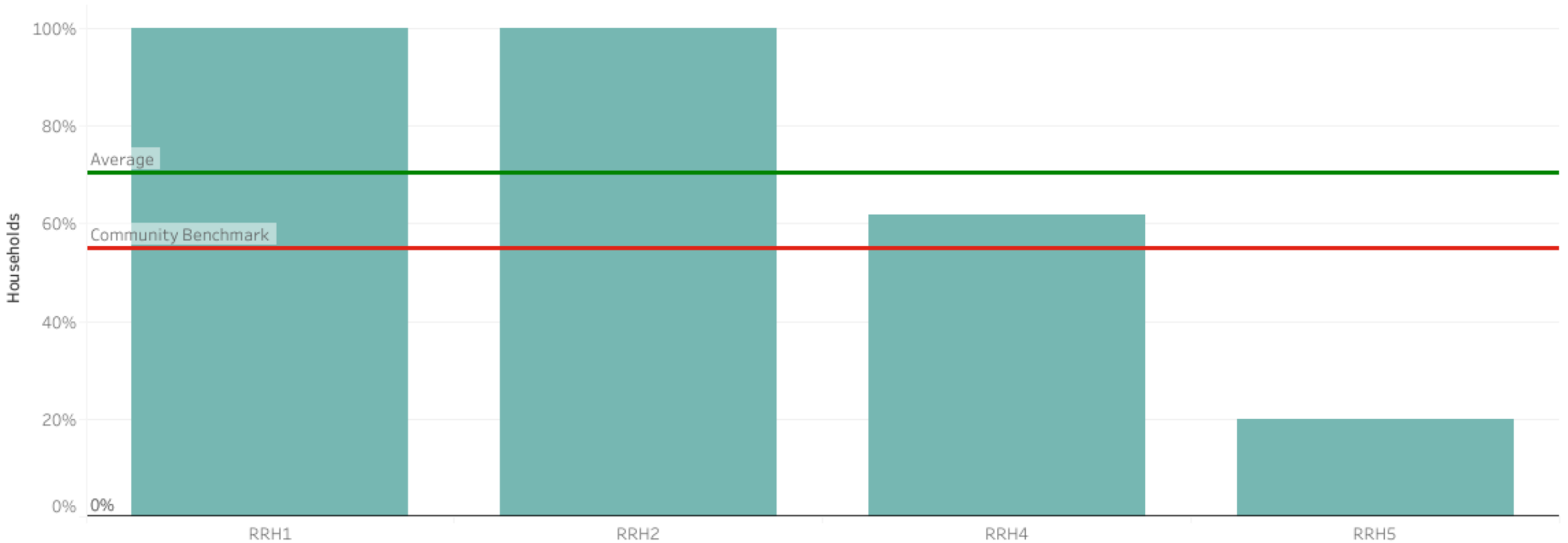

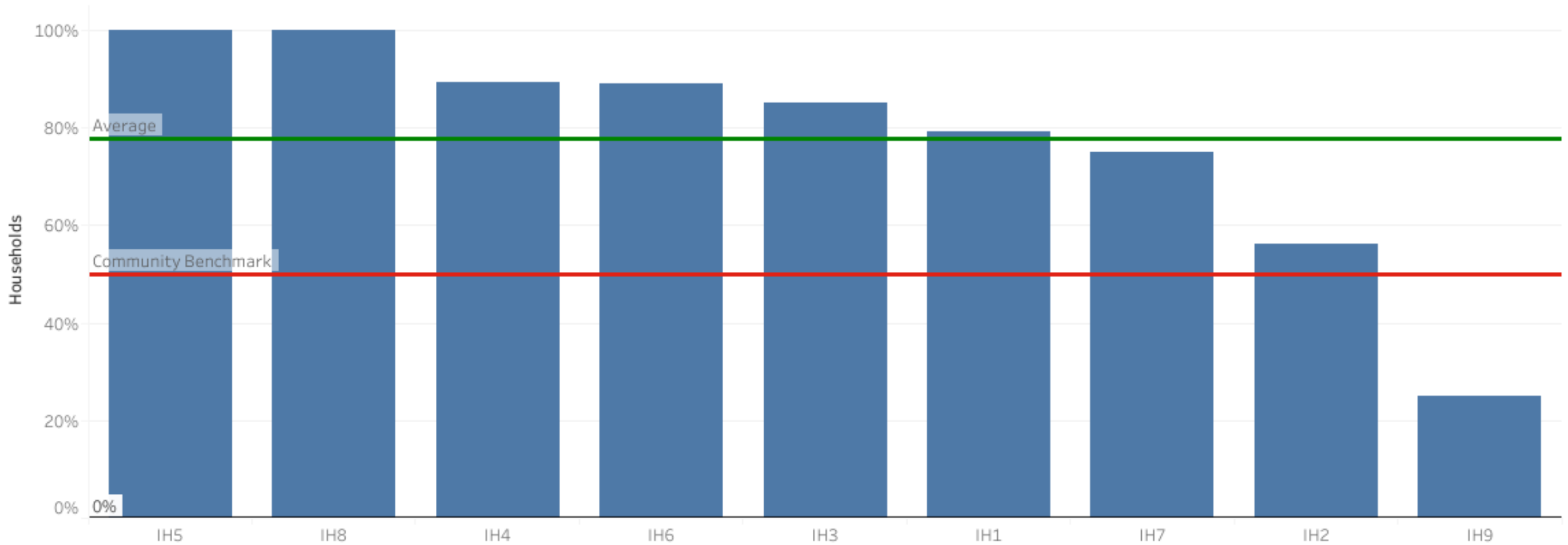

# Youth Exits to Permanent/ Stable Housing (2018)



**Youth TH SS** - 70% of participants will exit to stable housing

**Youth TH Project Based** – 60% of participants exit to stable housing

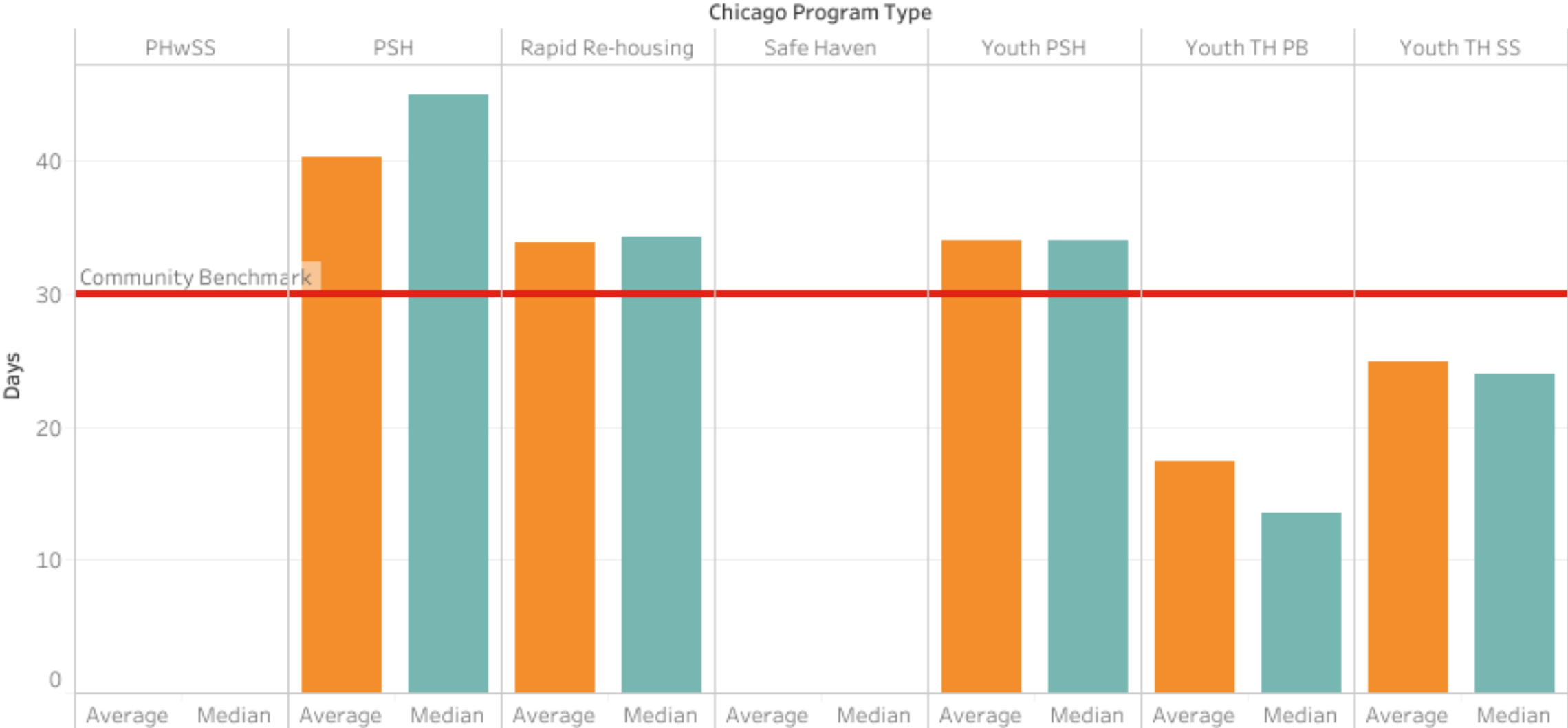
(family, friends, longer-term shelter/housing programs or permanent housing)

June

- Finalize Data Points with SPEC
- Present Draft Dashboards at All CoC Meeting for feedback
- Present Draft Dashboards with DFSS Staff
- Resolve questions from SPEC

July

- Present Draft Dashboard at Service Providers Commission for feedback
- Hold 2 focus groups with service providers for feedback

August

- Post de-identified dashboards to All Chicago website
- Share project codes with agencies
- Determine steps to identify projects and post publicly
