

## HUD Homeless Assistance Programs Chicago 2010 NOFA Public Ranking

*This document outlines Chicago's 2010 ranking policies and ranking order chart for HUD Homeless Assistance Programs.*

### **2010 Ranking Policies for New and Renewal Projects** *Approved by the Chicago Planning Council on Homelessness on July 21, 2010*

To be eligible for ranking, all projects, new and renewal, must pass all facets of the application review including:

- Projects must meet all HUD eligibility criteria.
  - Projects must meet the application deadlines, as set by the Chicago Planning Council on Homelessness.
  - Renewal projects must be pass the threshold criteria outlined in the 2010 NOFA Evaluation Instrument.
1. New Permanent Housing Bonus project(s), will be ranked in the order determined by the 2010 Bonus/ New Project Selection Panel.
  2. All renewal projects will be ranked, as outlined below:
    - a. Projects that score *50 or above* on the 2010 Evaluation Instrument, will be ranked separately by HUD program type (PH, SH, TH, SSO, and HMIS), in order of 2010 Evaluation Instrument score. Therefore, there will be five renewal project ranking lists horizontally listed, each starting with a number 1 ranking; projects will be listed by program type so that projects can compare themselves to similar projects.
    - b. All projects that score *below a 50* on the 2010 Evaluation Instrument will be ranked together separately, by 2010 Evaluation Instrument score. Any projects that score below a 50 on the 2010 NOFA Evaluation Instrument will be placed on funding probation; the projects will be placed on Chicago's 2010 funding priority list but will be required to attend a technical assistance session and propose a plan of action for improvement.
