Relevant NOFA Highlights and HUD Guidance

The FY2017 HUD Continuum of Care (CoC) Program Competition Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) is due by 7pm CST on Sept 28, 2017. Project Applications were required to be submitted to the Chicago CoC by August 24, 2017. HUD provided the following guidance regarding the ranking of funding priorities.

- All projects, except CoC planning applications, must be ranked in Tier 1 or Tier 2.
- Tier 1 is equal to 94% of the annual renewal demand (ARD), and Tier 2 is equal to the remaining 6% plus any amount available for bonus projects. This is a change from last year's competition, in which Tier 1 was equal to 93% of ARD.
- HUD will allow a project to straddle Tier 1 and Tier 2.
- Sections of the NOFA will be scored up to 200 points for:
 - CoC Coordination & Engagement – 43 pts.
 - HMIS – 13 pts.
 - PIT – 6 pts.
 - System Performance – 49 pts.
 - Performance & Strategic Planning – 60 pts.
 - Project Ranking, Review & Capacity – 29 pts.
- For New Projects & Renewals, up to 100 points will be awarded for:
 - CoC Score (application) – 50 pts.
 - CoC Project Ranking – 40 pts.
 - Housing First – 10 pts.
- The focus of HUD's Homeless Policy and Program Priorities for this NOFA are:
 - Ending homelessness for all persons
 - Creating a systemic response to homelessness
 - Strategically allocating and using resources

HEARTH FOTG Recommendations

The HEARTH FOTG reviewed the HUD ranking guidance, past ranking policies, system priorities and various other factors and recommended the following ranking policy for the HUD CoC Funded projects for FY2017 NOFA. The CoC Board of Directors reviewed and approved the policy on August 16, 2017.

Considerations and Rationale

The HEARTH FOTG met seven times between April and August 2017. Members underwent orientation on the Department of Housing and Urban Development’s (HUD’s) NOFA process, heard presentations from service and housing providers across the Continuum’s program models, and became familiar with the local evaluation instrument, project application and appeals processes to receive HUD CoC funding.

The HEARTH FOTG developed the ranking policy above with strong consideration for the local evaluation instrument scores, HUD guidance and Chicago’s Plan 2.0 to End Homelessness.

Coordinated Assessment SSO and HMIS

The HEARTH FOTG determined that the Coordinated Assessment and HMIS grants provide necessary resources to improve the capacity of the Chicago CoC to effect system change, improving the efficacy of projects across the city and supporting the realization of Plan 2.0. The HEARTH FOTG recommended placing these projects at the top of Tier 1. This includes three renewal Coordinated Entry SSO projects; a renewal HMIS project; and a new HMIS project to be funded through reallocation.

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Reallocation

The 2017 local evaluation instrument released in February 2017 included a question which allowed HUD-CoC funded service providers an opportunity to voluntarily reallocate a percentage of their grant(s) back to the Continuum of Care instead of returning the unspent funds to HUD. The voluntary reallocation amount was based on the average amount of funds that were returned to HUD over the past three years. Organizations had the opportunity to permanently reallocate the entire average or at least 80% of the average amount. Seven organizations (14 projects) agreed to reallocate grant funds. The total reallocation amount is \$540,225.

To prioritize high performing projects, the HEARTH FOTG recommended some of the projects funded through reallocation be placed in Tier 1. It was also recommended that one project straddle between Tier 1 and Tier 2.

Renewal Project Ranking

Because the local evaluation tool already accounts for considerations related to program model, the HEARTH FOTG did not separately rank renewal projects according to their program model type. The HEARTH FOTG ranked projects using the total local evaluation instrument score, averaging the last two years (2016 and 2017). Allocation to Tier 1 or Tier 2 was determined based on these rankings, bounded by the amounts allowed by HUD in each tier.

Bonus Projects

The HEARTH FOTG recommended that bonus projects for eight (8) types of programs – all eligible program types, be allowed to apply for up to \$3,823,676 in the FY2017 HUD CoC Program Competition. The HEARTH FOTG recommended placing the top 1/3 of bonus projects, ranked and divided into thirds by dollar amount, at the top of Tier 2 immediately after the straddle project. The HEARTH FOTG recommended the last 2/3 of bonus projects, ranked and divided into thirds by dollar amount, be at the bottom of Tier 2 after the remaining ranked renewal projects.
