Proposed Meeting Rules for Voting

1. All CoC Members (voting and non-voting) may speak to the motions.
2. Eligible voters will sit in a designated section of the auditorium, apart from general audience members, in order to make it easier for All Chicago support staff to count any potential raised-hand votes that may be necessary.
3. Each person wishing to speak to the current motion under deliberation will approach the microphone stand, state their name and group affiliation to be recorded for the speakers list. Individuals will speak in turn on a first-come basis.
4. All remarks will be addressed to the Chair.
5. Comments must be related to the issue under discussion.
6. Each speaker shall speak for no more than four minutes at a time. No person shall speak a second time until all who wish to speak first have done so.
7. Fifteen minutes will be allowed for a "Question & Answer" session for CoC members to ask questions regarding the voting item. No amendments shall be allowed at this time.
8. Formal discussions shall be limited to no more than thirty minutes allowing for balanced time, to the extent possible, for those who may be in favor or opposed.
9. These rules may be amended by a two-thirds vote of those members present and voting.
