- **Expedited Housing Initiative.** In its April meeting, the CoC Board endorsed a series of adjustments for our system that will influence the way people access permanent housing. The adjustments will expedite housing placements, ensure our system remains nimble during the crisis, and require system-level and provider-level adjustments. - Agencies are to maintain **recipient level and client level documentation of HUD waiver implementation.** Maintain a copy of the notification letter sent to HUD, the agency’s Emergency Recordkeeping Policies and Procedures and additional documentation of barriers and constraints.
